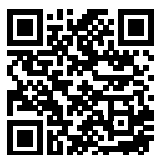

HOW SIGNING WORKS

The website form is not your petition signature. Eligible voters sign in person, in ink, on an official numbered City-issued petition page with a circulator present.

PUBLIC FAQ AND PROCESS

TRANSPARENT BY DESIGN

Recall questions, answered plainly.

The filed grounds, qualification rules, signature count, and timeline in one place.

HOW MANY SIGNATURES ARE REQUIRED?

The City Secretary set the requirement at 5,805 valid signatures. The campaign is aiming for at least 7,500 collected signatures to allow for signatures that may not be accepted.

WHO CAN SIGN?

A registered voter who currently lives within the incorporated City of McKinney. Voters from any McKinney district may sign.

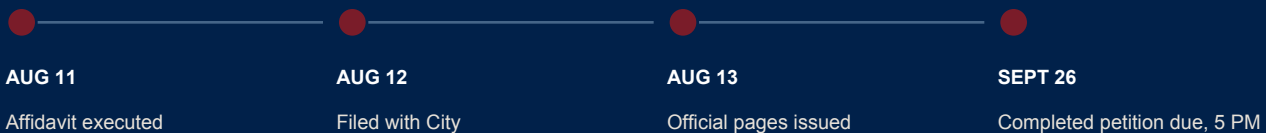
CAN I SIGN ONLINE?

No. Online forms do not count. An eligible voter signs in person on an official numbered City-issued petition page with a circulator present.

WHY ARE FOUR OFFICIALS NAMED?

The filed affidavit names four officials whose terms run to May 2029. The other three council seats are already on the regular May 2027 ballot.

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VOLUNTEER AND CIRCULATOR GUIDE

CIRCULATOR BASICS

- Use only official numbered City-issued petition pages.
- Stay present while each voter completes their own entry.
- Check for a complete McKinney residence address.
- Keep every official page in your custody.
- Complete the required circulator paperwork and training.
